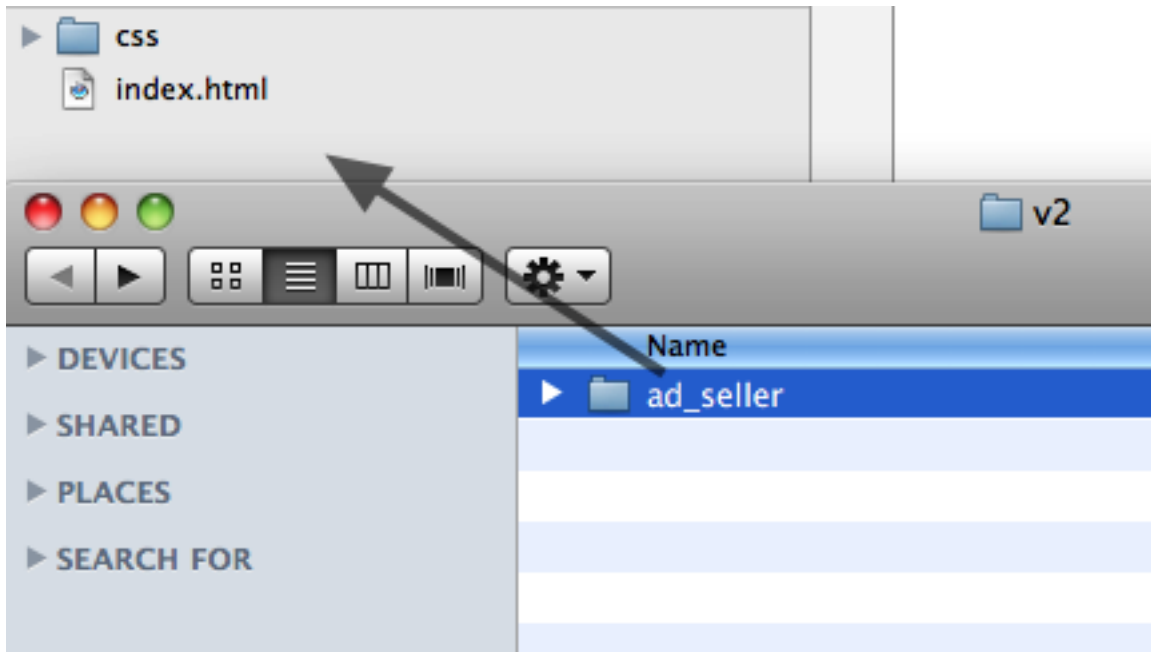


Uploading & Installing Ad-Seller v2

Thank you for purchasing Ad-Seller v2. In this part of the documentation I'm going to show you how to upload and install Ad-Seller v2

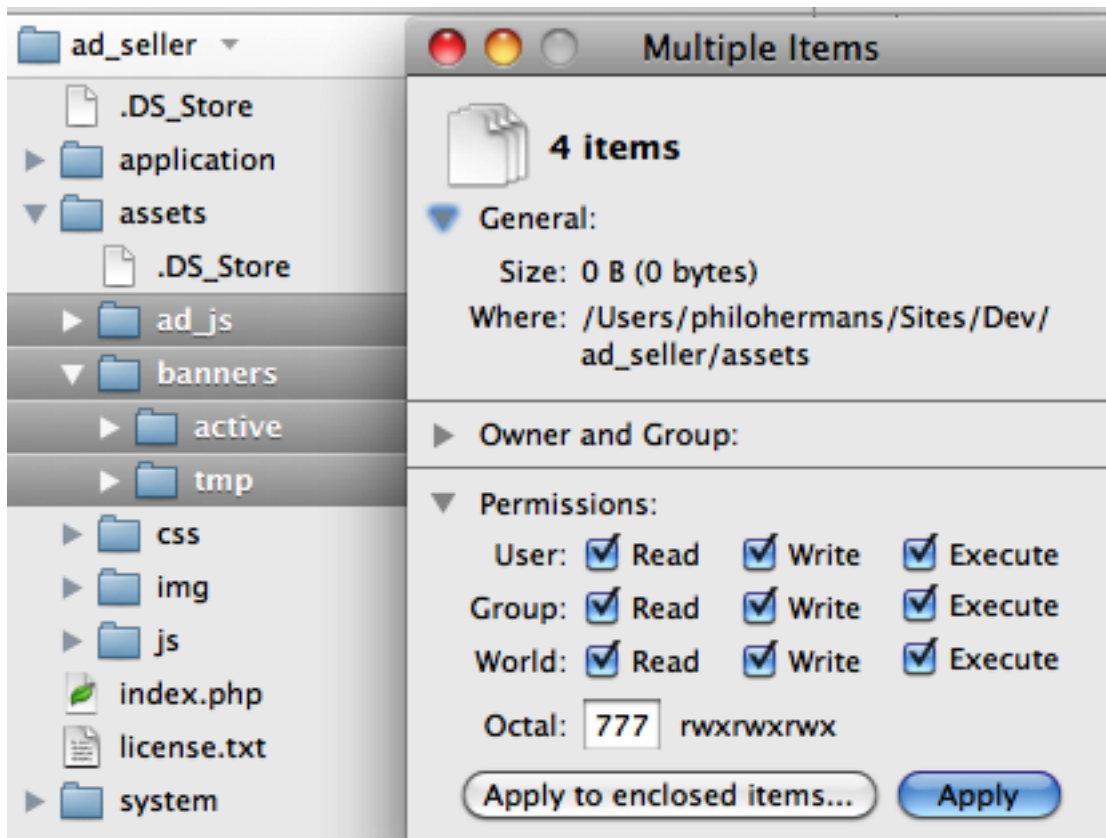
Upload Ad-Seller



Please upload the ad_seller folder to your webserver using an ftp client.

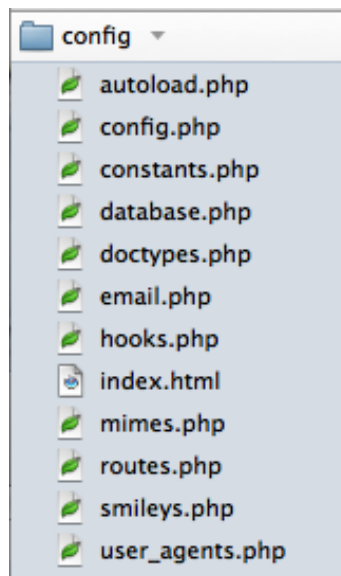
If you don't know how to get access to your website FTP, please contact your hosting company.

CHMOD 777



Ad-Seller needs write permission for some folder, so please CHMOD the folders "**banners**", "**banners/active**", "**banners/tmp**" and "**ad_js**" - 777

Rename Config Files



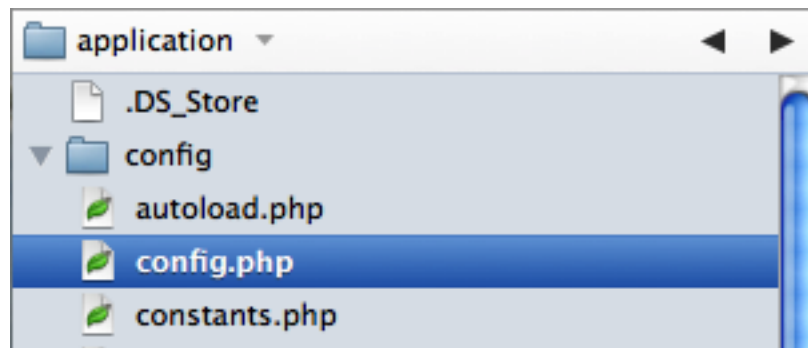
Please go into the folder **ad_seller/application/config/** and rename the following files:

config_default.php => config.php

database_default.php => database.php

It should look like the screenshot above.

Edit Config Files



Please open `ad_seller/application/config/config.php`

Edit Base Site URL

```
/*
-----
Base Site URL
-----
URL to your CodeIgniter root. Typically this will be your base URL,
WITH a trailing slash:
    http://example.com/
*/
$config['base_url'] = "http://www.ad-seller.net/ad_seller/";
```

Please see the step image as an reference.

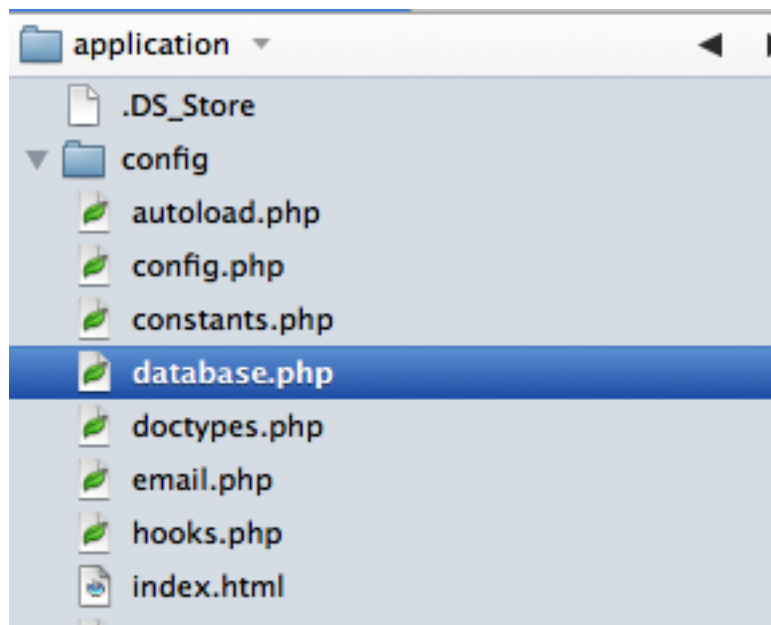
Please replace:

`$config['base_url'] = "http://yourdomain.com/";`

With the URL to the location where you uploaded `ad_seller`.

Don't forget the trailing slash! Save and close the file when you are done!

Open database.php



Please open `ad_seller/application/config/database.php`

Edit Database Connectivity Settings

```
$active_group = "default";
$active_record = TRUE;

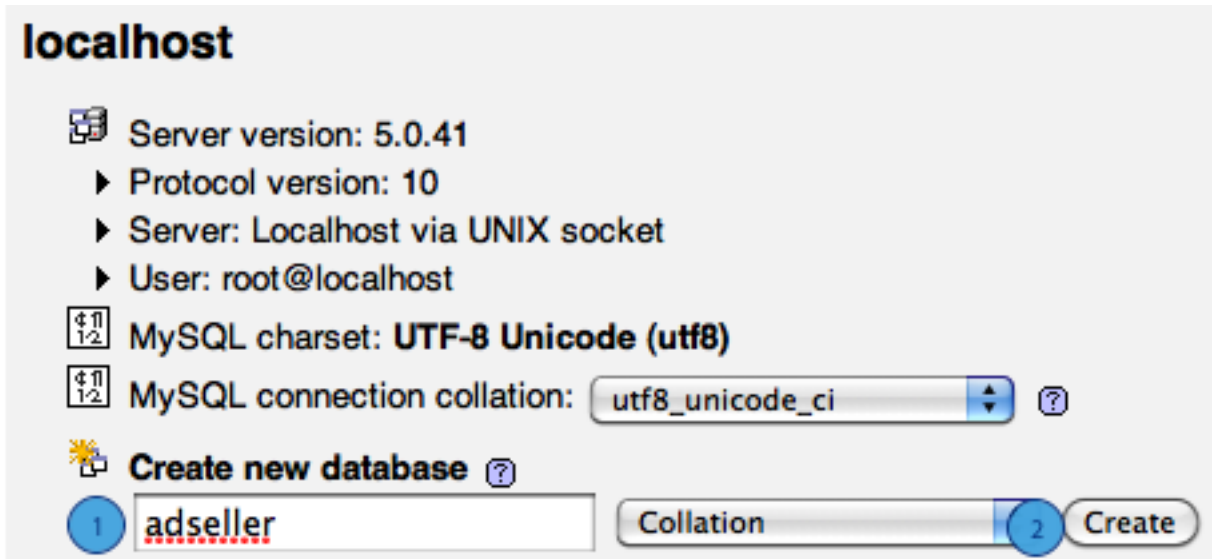
$db['default']['hostname'] = "localhost";
$db['default']['username'] = "root";
$db['default']['password'] = "secretpassword";
$db['default']['database'] = "adseller";
$db['default']['dbdriver'] = "mysql";
$db['default']['dbprefix'] = "";
$db['default']['pconnect'] = TRUE;
$db['default']['db_debug'] = TRUE;
$db['default']['cache_on'] = FALSE;
$db['default']['cachedir'] = "";
$db['default']['char_set'] = "utf8";
$db['default']['dbcollat'] = "utf8_general_ci";
```

Please replace the default info:

```
$db['default']['hostname'] = "localhost";
$db['default']['username'] = "";
$db['default']['password'] = "";
$db['default']['database'] = "";
```

So it matches your server settings, see the step image as an example.

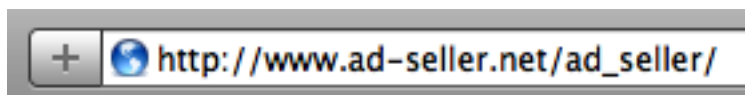
Create Database



Please go to your server database manager, in most cases this is PHPMyAdmin.

Make sure the name of the database matches the one you defined in the database.php config file.

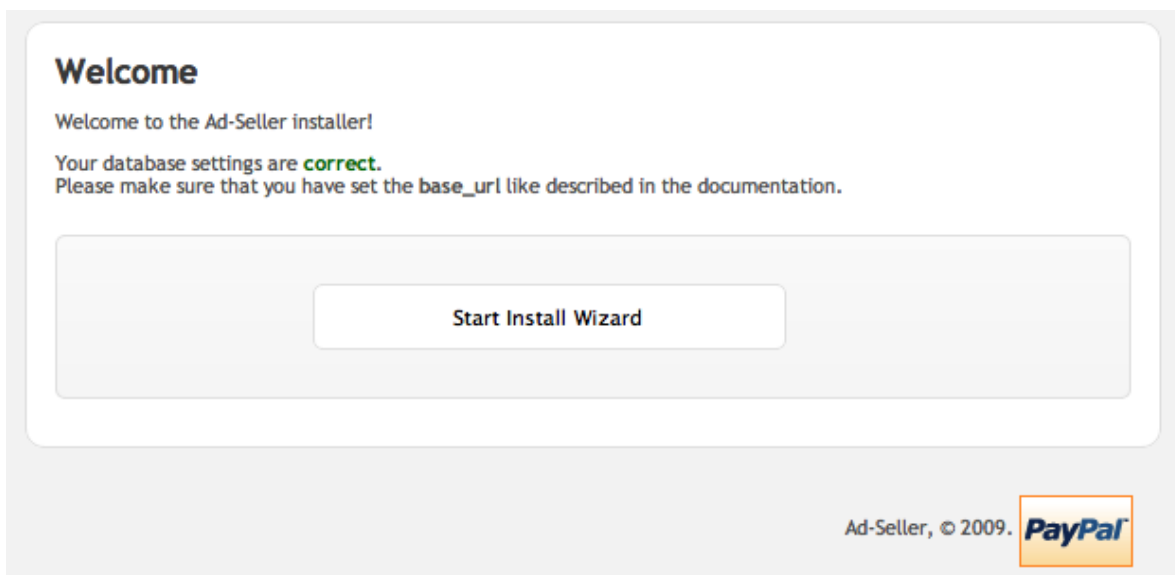
Go to the installer



Now that everything is set, we can start the installer.

You can do this by going to the url where you upload the application.

Starting the install wizard



If everything went correct, the install wizard should display.

Press **Start Install Wizard** when ready!

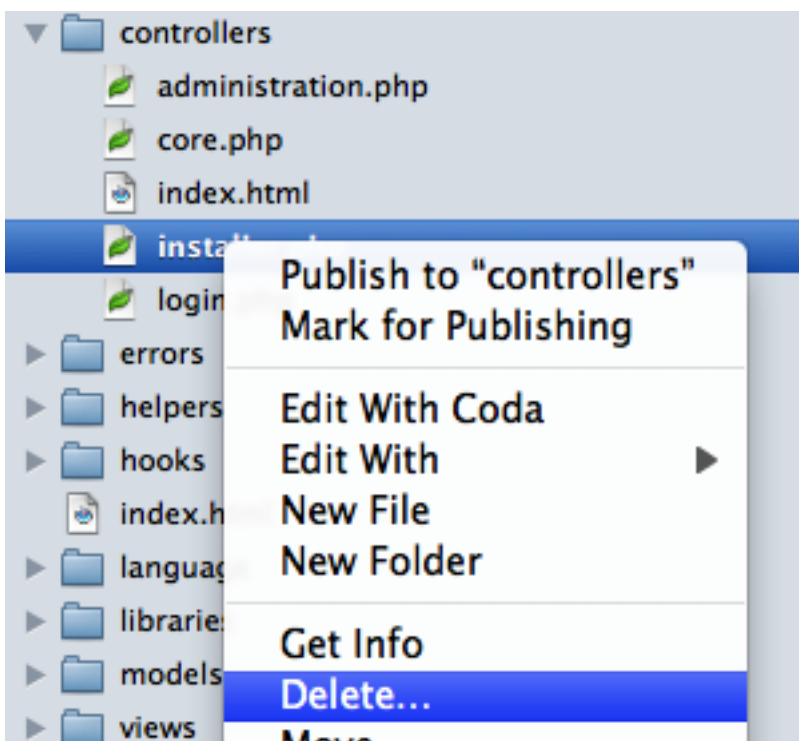
